The 2022 edition of "**YOUNG AMBASSADOR FOR PEACE**" / "**YOUNG AMBASSADOR FOR DEVELOPMENT**" of Université Côte d'Azur program is launched in October 2021!

Through a call for applications, its goal is to support each year the winning projects in each one of the two fields and, thus, to appoint a "Young Ambassador for Peace" (JAP) and a "Young Ambassador for Development" (JAD) of Université Côte d'Azur.

The programme thus aims to support the two winning projects, developed by international students during their mobility at Université Côte d'Azur and to be implemented upon their return to their home university.

The call for projects is opened to international students on mobility at the Côte d'Azur University during the academic year 2021-2022.

It concerns two areas: peace and development. Each candidate can submit a project in either field.

At the end of the selection process conducted by a jury, the winning project in each of the two fields will be supported in terms of preparation during the mobility course at UCA (assistance in setting up, organisation, etc.), then formally supported (presence of a representative of UCA, the IdPD at the event organised, etc.) and financially (small contribution to the costs of carrying out the project, depending on its nature).

The call is launched on October 15, 2021.

The deadline for submitting the projects is December 15, 2021 at noon. The applications, using the attached matrix, must be sent by email (and specifying "Young Ambassador 2022 Application" in the subject line) to idpd@univ-cotedazur.fr (by December 15 at noon at the latest).

The candidates shortlisted following this phase will be invited to present their project orally to the jury at the beginning of January 2022.

A jury will then designate the two winners at the end of this second stage of the selection.

The winners (one on peace and the other on development) will be invited to present their projects at the IDPD's solemn Re-entry, during which their official appointment as UCA's Young Ambassador 2022 will take place, formalized by the presentation of a certificate.

Starting January 2022, the preparation of the implementation of the project will be accompanied.

The projects will receive assistance - this assistance will depend on the nature of the planned activities. Support may include scientific, organisational, financial or other form of backing.

Eligible applicants and projects:

The call for applications is open to international students hosted by Université Côte d'Azur during the academic year of 2021-2022.

Projects must focus on an activity related to either peace or development. Both concepts are broadly understood.

An applicant may only submit one project, either on peace or on development.

The activities described in the projects must be completely implemented by 31 December 2022.

Project evaluation criteria:

- > Quality of the project in relation to the chosen field (peace / development) / 30
- > Relevance of the project to the local, regional, national or even international context / 20
- > Feasibility and timetable of the actions envisaged / 20
- > Nature of the partners involved (in particular the student's home university) / 10
- > Expected impact of the project / 10
- > Planned dissemination strategy / 10
